### Uniform Policy

This policy was drawn up in conjunction with the Department for Education's statutory guidance: Cost of uniforms.

At Netherton Infant School, we believe that wearing school uniform is important because it promotes the ethos of the school and provides a sense of belonging and identity.

We recognise that school uniform should not be so expensive as to place an unfair burden on parents.

Our school uniform consists of:

- White polo shirt
- Blue sweatshirt or cardigan – with school logo or without
- Black/grey trousers, skirt or pinafore.
- Book bag – can be purchased from school or can bring own.
- Water bottle – containing water only

Our Netherton Infant school logo uniform items are supplied by Coniston embroidery. Any orders can be made through the school office.

Any plain, non-logo uniform items can be bought at local supermarkets.

As all our children go outside every day, we also recommend a warm, waterproof coat, hat, scarf and gloves during the winter, as well as a sunhat for summer months. Please ensure that every item of uniform is named.

We also have a thrift shop each term where you can buy second hand uniform. This takes place the first week of each new term after school outside the main school hall.

For safety reasons we ask that your child not wear a watch or jewellery to school, apart from jewellery worn for religious reasons; we cannot accept responsibility for any jewellery that is lost, damaged or broken in school. If your child has pierced ears, please note that only studs are acceptable in school and please ensure they are removed on PE days.
